



One thing that I love about coaching wrestling is the competitive attitude that develops in the practice room. This attitude is essential for a strong program, and it's not easy to build it. A program needs to invest in it and dig deep to discover it. The important thing to remember is that a strong work ethic will be contagious. Once the bug hits a few guys in the practice room, it spreads throughout the squad.

Some of you have begun to discover the benefits of off-season work, while others have committed to it for a long time now. These off-season opportunities provide an environment for growth that is free of pressure from your high school coaches, that is enjoyable and memorable, and that fosters motivation to succeed and inspiration to win

Whether you're a captain or not, senior or underclassman, you know that you have a great influence on younger wrestlers and youth wrestlers. You have a sense of brotherhood where you look out for one another. You help your brothers when they fall by the wayside. You are your brothers' keepers

I love this sport because it truly prepares you for success in life. Wrestling prepares you for the inescapable features of toil and pain that are present in the everyday workplace. It teaches you to persevere through the blood, sweat, and tears of life. As a wrestler, you'll be proud to show off your subtle badges of honor, whether it's a scar, a broken bone, or cauliflower ears.




