

Dear Wildcat Wrestling Family—

When people say congratulations on the 2015-16 season, the only thing I can say in reply is that it's been fun. It's as simple as that. This has been an incredibly fun season. The dedication and perseverance of the members of this program have paid off. This season's successes aren't the result of any one person's work; it's a culmination of the efforts of countless people, from the Louisburg Kids Wrestling Club to the middle school program, from the supportive parents at home to the encouraging teammates on the mat.

The efforts leading into this season resulted in many "historical" accomplishments: we won our first team championship since 2009 (when Coach Greg Darrington's squad won Fort Scott and Tonganoxie), we won our first Frontier League championship since 1997, we smashed the school record for most wins in a season with a 17-3 record (Coach Dee Graham's 1984 squad was 13-0), and we had our first state placers since 2012.

To the class of 2016: Thank you. The six of you have dedicated the last four years to Louisburg wrestling and I am so proud of what you've accomplished. Here are some of your accomplishments: 225 varsity wins, 1,231 team points, 13 team trophies, 2 team championships, a 42-24 dual record, 36 individual medals, and 3 individual tournament championships. Some of you have taken on the mantle of "captain," and it's been such a pleasure to witness <u>all</u> of you act like men and leaders, regardless of the title. I can't express to you enough how much I appreciate the role you've played on this team, as well as the guidance you've given the younger athletes in the program.

To the underclassmen, I want you to think about this quote: "Remember the guy that gave up? Neither does anyone else." This quote applies perfectly to wrestling. The governing fact of the sport is that it isn't easy. Ask anyone who has tried it before. You've hurt, you've been in constant pain, you've been exhausted... by sticking it out this season, you've discovered that it's worth it all to receive the honor of finishing the season. Look at the examples of our senior class. These six young men may not have seen their seasons end the way they dreamt they would, but they stuck it out through four years. They've given so much to help this program. Look to these young men for guidance; they've made it this far for a reason. Choose your role models carefully. When you reach the point where you ask yourself whether or not it's worth the pain, torture, and agony, what sort of leader will you follow: the one who quit because it was too difficult or the one who endured because he knew the rewards that lay at the end of the road?

To the managers and parents, I can't thank you enough for all of your never-ending support. Managers, for the last three and a half months you've willingly subjected yourselves to the odd and sometimes disgusting habits of the wrestlers on the team. Whether you know it or not, we recognize and appreciate the fact that you've often been our biggest and most vocal fans. Parents, you've arranged breakfasts for after weigh-ins and meals for the wrestlers at meets, and you've traveled many miles to spend your entire Saturdays sitting in gymnasiums to cheer on the team. You've stuck around after your own children have finished wrestling to cheer on the team, and you even traveled to competitions where your child wasn't even competing. The managers and parents together have done so much to truly make this a family.

Each season, we face countless obstacles that stand in the way of a "successful" season. Sometimes these obstacles seem to signify the end of our dreams. American author Ernest Hemingway once said, "The world breaks everyone, and afterward, some are strong at the broken places." When you feel like the world has broken you, what will you do?

While the 2014-15 season was a huge stride forward for the program, the 2015-16 has surpassed all that we did last year. We've got the momentum, the interest, and the talent to continue taking things in the right direction. The only thing we have left to do is to make the conscious choice to act on these things. Momentum fades, enthusiasm dwindles, and distractions pop up all over the place. You need to decide where to go from here. You need to sit down and set concrete goals with a definite strategy to accomplish those goals. You need to look at your options, whether it's Freestyle and Greco-Roman, the Sunflower State Games, the Outdoor Challenge Camps, or participating in our open mat workouts this summer. These things have definitely helped get us to where we're at now.




